The University of Liverpool and local NHS partners are investing in a major new programme of immunology cancer research to help translate new discoveries into novel treatments for patients as quickly as possible.

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Prime Minister announces £20m to Grow Medicines Manufacturing in the UK

GOV.UK The UK's ability to respond to future pandemics will be strengthened thanks to a new £20 million fund to expand medicines manufacturing, Prime Minister Boris Johnson has announced. This will open up investment opportunities for medicines manufacturers in England, Scotland and Wales – improving domestic medicine supply chains and creating thousands of highly skilled jobs in the process.

Established as part of a £30.5 million international research consortium, primarily funded by Unitaid, the Centre of Excellence for Long-acting Therapeutics will be the first of its kind in the world.

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Testing Lab Data Reveals Spread of New Covid Variant Across the Country

CATAPULI Scientists at the Alderley Park Lighthouse Lab in Cheshire have revealed the speed and scale at which the new variant of the COVID virus is spreading through communities across the country. Its scientists have identified the new COVID variant in the lab's PCR test and have been able to use this new science to track the spread of the new COVID variant across England and Wales.
