Abstract submission deadline: Friday 28th February

The prevention of cancer and development of more effective strategies to detect precursors and early-stage cancers, when treatment may be most effective, remain critical societal goals.

The 2020 Bionow Oncology Conference will present the problems that we face with prevention and early diagnosis and discuss the latest advances to address these challenges and translate the science into better care for the cancer patient. In addition to leading experts we will also hear about this challenge from the patient's perspective.

Cancer is always a complex question and there are no simple answers which is why it's important to hear from those at the cutting edge of developments.

Poster submissions at the conference will provide an opportunity to showcase on-going research projects and speculative or innovative work in progress relating to the study of cancer. The posters are intended to provide authors and participants with the ability to connect with each other and engage in discussions at the work.

Authors must submit an abstract of no more than 300 words in English outlining aims, objectives, methodology and conclusions. The abstract must be prepared in A0 size (841 x 1189mm) in either portrait or landscape format.

Poster boards will be provided for authors to display to delegates throughout the conference, ensuring that the poster is staffed by at least one person from your organisation during all breaks.
