Ground-breaking cancer research at the University of Huddersfield leading to EPSRC award

Finding effective treatments for cancer is tremendously difficult. Current conventional and targeted chemotherapy drugs present their own challenges as their poor selectivity, the rapid emergence of drug resistance and limited utility meaning that not all patients will receive benefit from the treatment.

However research looking into the selectivity of compounds at the University of Huddersfield has been published in the respected journal, Nature Communications and demonstrated excellent results with the potential to make cancer treatment more effective, accessible and active against cancers that are resistant to current chemotherapies.

Alcyomics® to transform drug discovery for osteoarthritis treatment with unique in vitro bio-printed 3D tissue model

Alcyomics has developed a unique in vitro model of the human osteoarthritic joint as a participant of the CRACK IT Innovation programme from the UK's National Centre for the Replacement, Refinement and Reduction of Animals in Research (NC3Rs) in а project sponsored GlaxoSmithKline and co-funded by Arthritis Research UK and EPSRC. Alcyomics's model incorporates human bone, cartilage, and nerve lineages to mimic the human joint including pain sensitisation. Successful bioprinting of the model allows for consistent, high-throughput manufacture of the models to assist in large screening assays. Having successfully completed the development phase, Alcyomics has been awarded an NC3Rs Business Growth Scheme (BGS) project to commercialise its unique OA model as a wider offering to the pharmaceutical development market.



Aptamer Group signs two substantial new contracts

A cure for resistance? How ultra-long patent terms may entice pharma to address the antimicrobial resistance crisis

Antimicrobial resistance (AMR) is a rapidly emerging crisis, and it is already estimated that antibiotic resistance alone caused 1.27 million deaths and contributed to 4.95 million deaths in 2019 (more deaths than HIV/AIDS or malaria) [1]. This is only set to increase as our use of existing antimicrobials accelerates in response to population, environmental, and healthcare pressures.

And it is not just antibiotic resistance to common bacterial pathogens that poses the greatest challenge, although this is undoubtedly huge. Resistance emerging in viruses, parasites, and fungi are threatening global progress towards eradicating major complex diseases such as HIV/AIDS and malaria.
